DELIVERY OF FINAL GROUNDWATER GEOCHEMISTRY REPORT (PART OF THE SITEWIDE CHARACTERIZATION STUDY) - LAG- 072-94

Due to a delay in receiving Department of Energy, Rocky Flats Field Office (DOE, RFFO) review comments on the draft *Groundwater Geochemistry Report*, EG&G is requesting a modification of the delivery date for the final 1994 *Groundwater Geochemistry Report*. Although the final report could be ready by December 28, 1994, delivery at this time would be difficult due to the holiday break. Therefore, EG&G Rocky Flats, Inc. proposes to deliver the report to DOE, RFFO during the first week of 1995.

The *Groundwater Geochemistry Report* (Volume III of the Sitewide Characterization Study) evaluates all data for groundwater samples collected sitewide from 1990 through the first quarter of 1994, and is the companion report to the *Groundwater Geochemistry Report* (Volume 1) and the *Hydrogeological Characterization Report* (Volume II). The *Groundwater Geochemistry Report* includes results from spatial statistical analysis (kriging), geochemical modeling (speciation and mass-balance calculations) and stable-isotope analysis, as well as numerous graphical representations of groundwater chemistry at RFETS.
