
Dear Mr. Gunderson and Mr. Rehder:

Pursuant to the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site's (Site) notification of July 23, 1998, (reference letter 98-DOE-03785), this letter transmits the enclosed Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement (RFCA) required source evaluation plan (Plan) which addresses monitoring results reported for RFCA Point of Evaluation surface-water monitoring location SW027 (located in the South Interceptor Ditch upstream of Pond C-2 in the Woman Creek basin). The Plan fulfills the RFCA Attachment 5, Section 2.4(B), requirement for a "... plan and schedule for source evaluation. . ." to investigate the SW027 monitoring results.

As with the ongoing Walnut Creek source evaluation effort, the Site proposes to adopt a basin-wide approach to this Woman Creek source evaluation effort. Thus, any additional monitoring results that trigger reporting under RFCA will be incorporated, with revisions as needed, in this latest Source Evaluation Plan.
