

process will include consideration of consensus views expressed by the CAB. Prior to construction and operation of the storage facility, the additional plans and designs outlined in the application must allow for public input and be submitted for approval by the State.

CAMU siting criteria favor contaminated areas over uncontaminated. This preference influenced the choice of the selected location, which includes all or part of several Individual Hazardous Substance Sites (e.g., IHSSs 101, 165, and 176). Construction can only proceed where it will not interfere with IHSS remediation.
