Dear Colleagues, Fellow Citizens and Friends

Enclosed for your information and comment is the draft Decommissioning Program Plan (DPP) for the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (Site). The DPP describes how many aspects of the building decontamination and decommissioning (D&D) program will be implemented at the Site. Subjects addressed by the DPP include interactions between Site personnel and the regulators, when decision documents are required for building disposition activities, the contents of D&D decision documents, and a general description of the D&D process, among others.

The DPP is a regulatory decision document being prepared pursuant to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement. As such, it is subject to final approval by our regulators (the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment) following a formal public comment period. The U.S. Department of Energy, Rocky Flats Field Office, is making the DPP available for public comment beginning April 17, 1998, and ending June 17, 1998. All comments received during that time will be considered and addressed through changes to the document, and/or in a responsiveness summary appended to the final document.


