REQUESTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ROCKY FLATS PLANT SITE DEIS (ERDA-1545-D)
PUBLIC HEARING, MAY 24, 1978

Requests to become full participants in the subject hearing were received within the May 15 deadline from the following listed organizations or individuals. The material submitted is enclosed. However, some of the formal submittals have not been received and will be transmitted to you when received.

1. Ed Martell, NCAR, Box 3000, Boulder, CO 80307, made a phone request May 3, for 15-20 minutes to discuss the following items in the Staff Statement: (3) Health Effects and Dose Calculations; (6) Environmental Monitoring, Analysis and Standards. He indicated that he has a formal critique of the EPA soil standards guidance and he feels that there is an inadequate basis for actinide exposure standards. He noted that he did not submit formal comments on the DEIS.
2. Tony Roisman, NRDC, 917 15th Street, NW., Washington, DC 20005, made a phone request to Steve Greenleigh, May 8, for two hours to discuss the issue raised in their formal comments regarding the need for coverage of the total U.S. nuclear weapons program. The formal submittal was received May 15 and is enclosed. It lists Roisman and Tamplin as the witnesses and the time requested is 30 minutes.
3. Brenda Williams from Albert J. Hazle's office in the Colorado Department of Health, 4210 E. 11th Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80220, called May 10 to request 35 minutes for the State of Colorado. They plan to have two participants, Anthony Robbins, Executive Director, CDH and William P. Rogers of the Colorado Geological Survey.

4. A formal request for 20 minutes, dated May 1, and an attached summary was received May 9, from Carl J. Johnson, Director of Health, Jefferson County Health Department, 260 S. Kipling Street, Lakewood, Colorado 80226. The summary of his statement is enclosed.
5. David Ehrman from Senator Haskell's office in Denver requested a few minutes via phone May 11, to present a brief statement regarding the Senator's perception of the Rocky Flats Plant operation.
6. Dr. John Cobb, University of Colorado Medical Center, 4200 E. Ninth Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80220, requested three hours via phone May 12, to call up witnesses and discuss the issues raised in his comment letters which he said were not adequately addressed in either the DEIS or Staff Statement.
7. Elizabeth Lui, American Lung Association, 809 N. Cascade, Colorado Springs, Colorado 80903, requested that she become a participant via phone May 12, to discuss related health costs of pollution and health effects of radiation. She was tentatively allotted 15 minutes pending her review of the DEIS.
8. An undated letter was received May 12, from Henry C. Raibourn, 876 14th Street, Boulder, Colorado 80302, requesting that he become a limited participant or observer but does not plan to make a statement (letter enclosed).
9. Mr. Paul Smith, Regional Radiation Representative, EPA, Region VIII, 1860 Linden Street, Denver, Colorado 80295, requested 15 minutes via phone May 15--letter will follow.
10. Paul Wehr, Sociology Department, University of Colorado, requested ten minutes via phone May 15 (formal request was mailed May 11) to discuss security and terrorism which he does not feel is adequately covered in the DEIS.
11. David Cortright, Executive Director, SANE, requested 15 minutes via phone May 15. The formal submittal was delivered May 15 and is enclosed.

12. Robert Westek, City Manager of Boulder, Colorado, phoned May 15 to indicate that he would submit for the record a copy of a resolution that was submitted earlier to ERDA concerning the continuation of the Rocky Flats Plant operations.

13. John P. Elliott, Jr., Chairman of the Rocky Flats Monitoring Committee, requests 20-30 minutes. A copy is enclosed.

15. Nina Hersh, 2505 Jupiter Avenue, Boulder, Colorado requested (received May 15) that she be permitted to testify as a member of the public. Her letter is enclosed.
