The OU2 documents provided to RCRA Regulatory Programs (RRP) have been reviewed for unresolved waste issues

The documents provided deal only with the RF/RI and do not explicitly address waste management issues A typical reference to waste handling activities is contained in the Phase II RF/RI Workplan Alluvial which states All field activities will be performed in accordance with the Rocky Flats Plant Environmental Restoration (ER) Program Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) This inclusion by reference of the ER SOP documents appears to be an appropriate means to describe the handling procedures for the RF/RI generated waste It is recommended that during the future generation of the workplans and ER SOP's that RCRA Regulatory Programs be included in the review process During the review process appropriate deviations from the waste management activities specified in the ER SOP's and/or RCRA permitting issues may be identified The early identification of these issues would allow for timely resolution

It is further suggested that RRP be included in the review process during the generation of IM/IRA and CM/RA documents for the previously stated reasons
