EG&G Rocky Flats, Inc (EG&G) is in the process of responding to the above referenced letter, and fully intends to meet the deliverable date of May 27, 1994. As staff discussions have indicated, however, the draft language submitted on that date will not fully replace the existing IAG. In the interest of establishing a clear understanding of what the May 27, 1994 deliverable will and will not be, the following points are offered as assumptions for the revision effort


- 1 This document covers a revision to Chapters 1 through 5 of the original IAG. These sections which constitute the main part of the Agreement cover General Provisions, Agency Responsibilities, and Common Provisions
- 2 The remaining parts of the original IAG are attachments which require the completion of the Project Baseline. This effort cannot be completed until various issues which impact planning assumptions have been resolved between the three parties to the Agreement. Discussions have been initiated on these issues and will continue over the next several months. Accelerated cleanup is one of the pending issues
- 3 In the revised agreement an attempt has been made to reorganize the various sections in a more logical order and also streamlining of the document has been accomplished by combining various interrelated sections. These changes have been discussed between the Department of Energy (DOE) and EG&G at the staff level, including both the negotiation and negotiation support teams
- 4 In order to produce a document that represents a unified EG&G position, internal discussions have been held with representatives from all EG&G organizations, and their ideas and comments have been incorporated
