Modifications to Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement Help Guide Cleanup Effort

The Department of Energy (DOE), Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are proposing modifications to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement (RFCA) that will guide the remainder of the environmental cleanup and help define the end-state of the Rocky Flats Closure Project. The modifications propose new soil action levels and a revised cleanup approach for the soils at Rocky Flats. Action levels are numerical values that, when exceeded, trigger an evaluation of possible cleanup actions.

The draft modifications will be subject to a 60-day public comment period. The comment period will run from Nov 12, 2002, to Jan 13, 2003. Please send written comments to:
