## Public Comment Period Extended for Modifications to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement

The public comment period for proposed modifications to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement (RFCA) has been extended to **January 31, 2002**. The RFCA is the regulatory agreement between the U S Department of Energy, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and U S Environmental Protection Agency that governs the required cleanup of radioactive and other hazardous substance contamination at the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site. The 60 day public comment period began November 12, 2002. Please send written comments to Rick DiSalvo, DOE, 10808 Highway 93, Unit A, Golden, CO 80403-8200.

The DOE is hosting a public meeting from **6 to 9 p.m. on Tuesday, December 17, at the Westminster Recreation Center, Community Room, 10455 Sheridan Blvd., Westminster, CO**.
