
The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment recently reviewed decision documents proposing the designation of two separate CAMUs at RFETS. As a point of clarification, the CAMU designations will cover RCRA-regulated remediation wastes; i.e., solid, hazardous, and mixed. Low-level wastes may be placed within either of the CAMUs, but should be segregated and handled according to applicable DOE orders. Any requirements prescribed by the receiving disposal facility will also apply to this waste and should be considered in the design and operation plans.
