RE: Permit Modification Request, #05-01, Emergency Coordinators

Dear Mr. Legare and Mr. Shelton:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the "Division"), has reviewed, and hereby approves, Permit Modification Request #05-01 received from DOE and Kaiser-Hill on March 16, 2005. This Class 1 permit modification request, requiring prior written approval from the Division, incorporates changes to Part VIII, Contingency Plan, Attachment E. The attachment lists the Emergency Coordinators for the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (RFETS) under RCRA Permit No. CO-04-06-23-01 (the "Permit").

Specifically, the revision replaces named individuals with the RFETS Fire Dispatch Center (the "Center"), and the Center's phone number. The center is staffed 24-hours daily, year round. In approving this change from named individuals, the requirements of 6CCR 1007-3, Section 264.55 Emergency Coordinator, must be maintained. Each shift of the Center must be staffed by a minimum of one individual *thoroughly familiar with all aspects of the facility's contingency plan, all operations and activities at the facility, the location and characteristics of waste handled, the location of all records within the facility, and the facility layout. In addition, [these] person[s] must have the authority to commit the resources needed to carry out the contingency plan.*

In accordance with Section 100.511(b) of the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations, this approved permit modification shall become effective immediately. Procedures for appeal of this decision are contained in Section 100.514. Enclosed for reference is page VIII-16, as revised on March 29, 2005, showing the relevant changes. Also enclosed for internal distribution is replacement page VIII-16, the new attachment E. Please ensure that all copies of the permit are updated.




