Dear Mr. Gunderson and Mr. Aguilar:

This letter transmits to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement (RFCA) Coordinators for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment two copies each of the fiscal year 2005 (FY05) Integrated Monitoring Plan (IMP) and its background document. Significant changes have been integrated into this year's IMP to describe monitoring that has been designed for transition from an operating decommissioning Site to a passive one with a minimum of man-induced disturbance. The FY05 IMP includes significant streamlining and refocusing of the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site's (Site) groundwater monitoring, and anticipates pending changes in the surface water monitoring and air monitoring that will occur when accelerated actions are completed later this calendar year. Ecological monitoring is likewise reduced in scope.

Copies of these documents are also being distributed this week to representatives of local governments and stakeholder organizations. A copy will be transmitted to the Rocky Flats Reading Room as well. Copies of this document are initially being hand carried to the agencies and organizations noted in this letter to expedite their distribution. Additional copies of the FY05 IMP will be available from the Department of Energy (DOE) and its contractor until the copies are exhausted or requests for the document cease.

We anticipate there will be a need for additional minor revisions to the IMP over the next several months. These revisions will be discussed and reviewed through the RFCA consultative process during that time. These revisions will be distributed electronically as CDs and via limited hardcopy inserts in a final quarterly update prior to completion of accelerated actions.


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Upon DOE acceptance of Physical Completion, DOE's Office of Legacy Management (LM) will assume responsibility of all long-term surveillance and maintenance of the Site including the environmental monitoring. The activities of LM, including site inspections, operations and maintenance, and environmental and institutional control monitoring, will be described in a Long-Term Surveillance and Maintenance Plan (LTS&M Plan). The LTS&M Plan is currently being prepared for your review, will incorporate large portions of the FY05 IMP, and, upon approval, will supercede the FY05 IMP.

The LM will introduce this approach to stakeholders beginning with the Closure Transition Meeting in June.


