Dear Mr. Schmitt:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the Environmental Protection Agency hereby approve the final modifications to the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement dated May 28, 2003. This approval includes the following attachments:

- RFCA Attachment 5, *Action Levels and Standards Framework for Surface Water, Ground Water and Soils.*
- RFCA Attachment 10, *RCRA Closure for Interim Status Units;* and
- a new RFCA Attachment 14, *Original Process Waste Lines (OPWL) Subsurface Soil Approach.*

The approval of these modifications is the result of several years of agency and community consultation concerning how accelerated actions are to be conducted at Rocky Flats, including the establishment of soil action levels. Finalizing these changes represents a significant accomplishment for all parties.


