DOE, EPA, CDPHE to Host Rocky Flats Public Meeting

Broomfield, Colo., May 24, 2006 – The U.S. Department of Energy Rocky Flats Project Office, the U.S. Environment Protection Agency, and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment will host a pre-release public meeting on the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study/Comprehensive Risk Assessment (RI/FS/CRA) and the Proposed Plan for the cleanup of the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site the evening of May 30, 2006.

The RI/FS/CRA document provides the basis and documentation for several CERCLA requirements, including the Proposed Plan and final Record of Decision. The Proposed Plan is a document used to facilitate public involvement in the remedy selection process. The document presents the DOE's preliminary recommendation concerning how best to address contamination at the site, presents alternatives that were evaluated, and explains the reasons the preferred alternative is recommended.

Representatives from the three agencies will discuss and answer questions regarding the changes to the draft RI/FS/CRA and what to expect in the Proposed Plan, which will be released for public comment in June 2006.
