SUPER SCIENCE BOWL XIV

CINCINNATI –Twenty-four teams representing high schools in Ohio and Kentucky will compete in the 14th annual Greater Cincinnati Regional Science Bowl sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Fluor Fernald on Saturday, Feb.5, at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College.

The competition will begin at 9 a.m. and will consist of oral question-and-answer rounds on a range of topics including physics, biology, chemistry and mathematics. Volunteers from DOE and Fluor Fernald will coordinate and run the contest. The final round will begin at 3:30 p.m.

The winner of the Cincinnati regional competition will advance to the National Science Bowl in Washington D.C. in May to compete against high school teams from around the country. One international and four domestic trips will be awarded to the top five winning national teams. The Cincinnati Country Day team won last year's regional competition.

DOE established the National Science Bowl in 1991 to improve math and science education in the United States and encourage students to explore careers in science, engineering and technology. "It's encouraging to see these students excel in subjects that are so vital to the future of America," said Bill Taylor, DOE-Fernald director.
