- * A conference was held of the NYDO Production, Security and Medical Divisions on the formulation of plans in the event of disasters at our plants. It was decided to invite contractor representatives to present their present plans in this connection with a view toward coordination and overall synchronization for the entire NYDO.
 - * The Medical Director had a conference at the Argonne National Laboratory on problems arising from the disposal of radioactive waste materials.
 - * The Chief, Health and Safety Branch delivered a paper at the conference of the American Industrial Hygiene Association at Boston, Mass. on "Environmental Studies in Plants and Laboratories Using Beryllium".
- Representatives of the Industrial Hygiene Section monitored a uranium rolling operation at the Armco-Rustless Iron and Steel Division of the American Rolling Mill Company, Baltimore, Md.
- * A survey team of the Industrial Hygiene and Radiation Survey Sections headed by the Chief, Health and Safety Branch, began a thorough health study of operations by the Harshaw Chemical Company, Cleveland, Ohio. Future reports will give progress and details of this study which began on April 6.
- A conference was held with representatives of the Kellex Corporation in order to discuss various health matters pertaining to their operations
