It would be appreciated if your office would exchange 3 feet of 3/4" diameter normal uranium metal rod for an equal weight of 1" diameter normal metal rod for the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc., at Boston, Massachusetts.


The SF material presently in use at the Manufacturing Laboratories is part of the 500 lbs. of uranium metal that was supplied to the Frankford Arsenal in July of 1952. Since that time this uranium metal has been transferred to the SF Materials Accountability Officer for Watertown Arsenal in accordance with U.S.A.E.C. regulations in your Bulletin GM-PRO-2, "SF Accountability". Mr. James L. Doherty has recently replaced Dr. L. Foster as SF Materials Accountability Officer for Watertown Arsenal.

It will be suggested to Mr. P. Kulin of the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc., that any future inquiries concerning uranium metal in his possession should be directed to your office thru the SF Materials Accountability Officer for Watertown Arsenal. This arrangement might eliminate unnecessary delays in future requests.
