Dear Mr. Belmore:

As per your request to Jim Murray, I am writing to give you the information on our present and prospective thorium production. We are at the present time producing approximately 22,000 pounds per month of thorium nitrate. We have under way an expansion program which we are hopeful will be in effect in late summer this year. With this increased production, we estimate that our monthly output of thorium nitrate will be 40,000 pounds per month.

With regard to what quantities we might have available for sale to the Atomic Energy Commission, with our present production of approximately 20,000 to 22,000 pounds per month, we would have available around 12,000 pounds monthly. With an increased production of around 40,000 pounds per month, we would probably have available approximately 25,000 pounds per month.
