Subject: SF Material at Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc.

Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter dated 12 March 1953, concerning normal uranium which will be transferred to the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc., in Boston, Mass., the following information is furnished:

1. At the present time no SF material has been shipped from the Frankford Arsenal to the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc. However, it is understood that a small portion of the SF material shipped to Watertown Arsenal from the Frankford Arsenal has been transferred to the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc. Information on the amount of material shipped to the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc., can be obtained from Watertown Arsenal, Accountability Symbol - WAR. It is expected that approximately 150 pounds of uranium metal will be shipped from Frankford Arsenal - FAR - to the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc.
2. It is expected that this SF material will remain at the Manufacturing Laboratories, Inc., approximately one year.
