

I have reviewed the attached site summary and elimination recommendation for the Titanium Alloy Manufacturing Company. I have determined that the potential for radiological contamination is low because of the limited duration of the activities at the site. Further, at least some of the contractual activities at the site were licensed under the Atomic Energy Act, and the licensed activities are thereby disqualified from further consideration under the Department of Energy's Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP).

Based on the above, the Titanium Alloy Manufacturing Company is hereby eliminated from further consideration under FUSRAP.
