Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and Section 40.21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10 - Atomic Energy, Chapter 1, Part 40 - Control of Source Material, you are hereby licensed to receive possession of and title to ten (10) pounds of thorium metal for use in experimental work relative to conversion of thorium scrap to anhydrous tetrachloride.

This license is subject to the right of recapture or control reserved by Section 108 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, and to all of the other provisions of said Act, now or hereafter in effect and to all valid rules and regulations of the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission. It is subject also to the provisions of the Atomic Energy Commission's proposed regulations entitled "Standards for Protection Against Radiation", published in the Federal Register on July 15, 1955 (10 CFR Part 20), until such time as said proposed regulations or the provisions thereof shall become effective regulations of the Commission. A copy of said proposed regulations is appended hereto.

Neither this license nor any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.

This license shall expire at midnight, November 30, 1956.
