SUBJECT: Authorization for Remedial Action at the Former Associate Aircraft Site, Fairfield, Ohio
TO: Manager, DOE Oak Ridge Field Office

This is to notify you that the Former Associated Aircraft Site in Fairfield, Ohio, is designated for remedial action under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). This notification does not constitute a FUSRAP baseline change control approval. Approval of the baseline change will be accomplished through the normal change control procedures.

The site was used by the former Atomic Energy Commission for the machining and shaping of uranium metal during the 1950s. A radiological survey found residual uranium within the building and in portions of the surrounding soil. Because of the limited extent of the contamination, the site may be remediated using the expedited remediation process now under development.
