



The Weldon Spring Interpretive Center opened in August 2002. Activities at the center reach over 20,000 members of the community each year. Between its opening date and the end of 2017, the center has received 298,060 visitors. This number includes visitors to the Interpretive Center (walk-ins, organized group tours, educational programs, meeting-room use), recipients of outreach presentations (primarily at area schools), and public participation events.

*NOTE: The decrease in 2013 attendance primarily resulted from closure/cancellations due to tornado damage and the partial government shutdown.
