Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) activities continue in Plant 6, the former Metals Fabrication Plant. MACTEC, the subcontractor performing the work is continuing interior demolition and removal of interior transite and asbestos contaminated pipe insulation in the building.

MACTEC is also continuing with the D&D activities at Plant 5 and work proceeds on schedule.
