### **Demolition Projects update**

Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) activities continue in Plant 5, the former Metals Production Plant. MACTEC, the subcontractor performing the work, is continuing with the removal of exterior transite and structural steel. By mid-January, exterior transite removal was 90 percent complete and removal of the structural steel was 60 percent complete

MACTEC is also on schedule with the D&D activities at Plant 6.

Currently, 90 components out of a total of 273 have been remediated. ### **Fernald Cleanup Progress Briefing**


