The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) February 27, 2001, letter requesting concurrence on the selected location for a new South Plume groundwater monitoring well to replace wells 2551 and 3551.

U.S. EPA understands that wells 2551 and 3551 have been plugged and abandoned, as the new landowner did not want the wells on his property.

U.S. EPA concurs with the new monitoring well location proposed by U.S. DOE and recommends the installation proceed.
