The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Project Specific Plan (PSP) for the installation of monitoring wells for the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF) cells four through seven.

The document provides a plan for installing Great Miami Aquifer groundwater monitoring wells for the OSDF cells four through seven.

The PSP appears adequate and U.S. EPA approves the document. However, U.S. DOE should delay installation of monitoring wells south of cell seven until a decision has been made on the need for cell eight.
