Enclosed for your review and approval is a revised Remedial Design (RD) Work Plan for the Silos 1 and 2 Project.

The original approved RD Work Plan (Reference 2) for the Silos 1 and 2 Project was based on an execution approach involving the award of a turnkey subcontract for the design, construction, operation, decontamination and demolition of the necessary facilities for implementation of the Silos 1 and 2 remedy. Milestones were established for award of the subcontract, and for the subsequent submittal of a schedule for RD deliverables.

The revised RD Work Plan is necessary to incorporate the change in the project execution strategy under the new Fernald Environmental Management Project Site Closure Contract


