### RE: CONDITIONAL APPROVAL TO COMMINGLE WASTE FROM D&D PROJECT

Dear Mr. Reising:

This letter provides conditional approval of your proposal as outlined in your letter DOE-0442-02 to commingle Category I materials from the D&D of the Administration Complex with Category A, B, D, and incidentally generated E materials. The strategy as outlined in the body of the letter is satisfactory. Briefly, the intent is to transport the debris directly to the OSDF in roll-off boxes during the OSDF's seasonal operating period. However, text in the body of the Implementation Plan for Above-Grade D&D of the Administration Complex including change pages allows stockpiling of these materials in certain cases. Some of the Category I miscellaneous materials including fabrics, drywall and building insulation can not be appropriately managed in stockpiles. We approve these changes only under the condition that these materials are not placed in stockpiles.
