The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) request for approval to place Incinerator pad soils in the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF).

The analytical results for soils samples presented in the document confirm the soils are below the waste acceptance criteria for the OSDF. Further clarification was also provided in the weekly conference calls. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the placement of the incinerator pad soils in the OSDF.
