The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) draft treatment plan for the removal of trichloroethylene from contaminated soil obtained from remediation area 3A and staged in Quonset Hut No. 1.

The document presents the treatment approach for soil contaminated with volatile organic compounds and describes the proposed post-treatment sampling.

The document and approach appears technically sound. U.S. EPA requests a few minor clarifications regarding the treatment plan and has included them in an attachment. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the treatment plan for Quonset Hut No. 1.
