The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Responses to Comments (RTC) and final treatment plan for the removal of trichloroethylene from contaminated soil obtained from remediation area 3A and staged in Quonset Hut No. 1.

The document presents the treatment approach for soil contaminated with volatile organic compounds and describes the proposed post-treatment sampling.
