TRANSMITTAL OF THE ON-SITE DISPOSAL FACILITY IMPACTED MATERIAL PLACEMENT PLAN ADDENDUM 2, REVISION 3

Enclosed for your review and approval is the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF) Impacted Material Placement Plan (IMPP) Addendum 2, Revision 3. This revision incorporates the modifications discussed in the May 10, 2004 Conference Call between the regulatory agencies and representatives from the U.S. Department of Energy and Fluor Fernald Inc. A technical memorandum prepared by GeoSyntec Consultant Inc. is also enclosed to explain the justifications for the modifications in more details per your request during the call. As presented in the memorandum and if implemented in time, these modifications can provide significant opportunities for us to further improve the long-term performance of the OSDF by maximizing the vertical distances between the materials that need to be placed according to this addendum and the final cover of the OSDF. Based on our actual field experiences and the current available placement space in the OSDF, a much more efficient placement operation of asbestos containing material (ACM) from ISO containers can also be achieved with this revision.

With your concurrence, limited implementation of this revision is already being conducted at the bottom of Cell 6 of the OSDF for ACM placement. Your quick approval is necessary for us to fully implement this approach and take full advantage of the opportunity it presents to further improve the long-term performance of the OSDF. Therefore, your quick review and approval of this important document will be highly appreciated.
