

**TRANSMITTAL OF THE SARA 313 ANNUAL INVENTORY OF TOXIC CHEMICALS REPORT**

Pursuant to 40 CFR 372, the Fernald Closure Project (FCP) has completed the annual Superfund Amendments Reauthorization Act (SARA) 313 Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) review. As a result of this review, it was determined that no SARA 313 chemical met the reporting threshold for "manufacture," "process," or "otherwise use" at the FCP for Reporting Year (RY) 2004. Therefore, no Form R submittal is required. As required, the supporting documentation upon which the determination was based will be maintained at the facility.

Enclosed is a completed "negative survey" form as requested by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency from facilities which have determined that no Form R is required.
