Lane,

The site ecologist (Jody Nelson) inspected the 123 topsoil and site conditions and has since recommended that the topsoil not be turned into the underlying soil to avoid bringing large rocks to the surface (similar to the Trench 1 site). Jody stated that the temporary seed mix should be applied directly to the topsoil. An approved hydromulch will be applied to the 123 site following seed application, which will stabilize the topsoil and prevent significant erosion. Based on this information, we do not plan to mix the topsoil as previously planned. Instead, the topsoil will be scarified and the approved temporary seed mix will be applied. The revegetation work is scheduled to begin tomorrow morning, weather permitting. Please let me know if this is not acceptable.
