The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the "Division") has completed reviewing the *Reconnaissance Level Characterization Report (RLCR) for the Building 371 Cluster (Revision 0, dated August 28, 2000)* and supporting data. In accordance with Section 3.3.4 of the *Decommissioning Program Plan*, the Division hereby concurs with the remaining determinations regarding facility classifications as follows: Tanks 167, 168, 169, 224, 225, 226, 227, and 228 are Type 2 facilities; Buildings 373, 374A, 377, 378, and 381 are Type 1 facilities; and Tanks 163, 164, 165, 170, 262, and 262A are Type 1 facilities. Since Tank 262 is an underground tank, it will require further characterization including appropriate radiological characterization when it is excavated.
