Purpose of Contact: Discovery of 4 X 1-gallon paint cans marked "FBI Ash" and proposed management.

Discussion: I called James to discuss proposed management of 4 paint cans, marked FBI Ash, discovered today in room 135 (Pilot Fluidized Bed Incinerator [FBI] an interim status treatment unit). These cans are located in an area under a portion of the unit, with gloveports on one side and a 3.5' X 3.5' metal plate with small filter on the other side. This material will be managed as remediation waste and based on process knowledge the material in the cans is assumed to be hazardous waste. Therefore, the outside of the glove access area has been labeled with four "Hazardous Waste" labels and the cans have been placed on a weekly inspection schedule, until the waste can be characterized and dispositioned. To facilitate the characterization and disposition process the environmental compliance group will work with radiological safety and operations personnel to determine the safest and most efficient access to these cans. After access has been gained, the waste will be characterized and dispositioned. This may be based on additional process knowledge (i.e., personnel interviews), analytical data or other appropriate means.
