**Purpose of Contact:** Discuss 2/19/99 approval of the 779 Decommissioning Operations Plan

**Discussion:** The Department of Energy cover letter describing minor modifications to the 779 Decommissioning Operations Plan which included (among other things) the elimination of EPA Codes D002 and D003 from certain Permitted Gloveboxes, did not accurately include all applicable gloveboxes. The cover letter only describes the removal of EPA codes D002, D003, & F003 from Unit # 90 43. Unit #'s 90 37 & 90 39 were inadvertently left out, for which EPA Codes D002 & D003 were also removed. Although the cover letter was incomplete, the attached Table (Attachment #1) accurately reflected the correct information. Chris was in agreement that these two Units (waste items) clearly do not exhibit the characteristic of corrosivity nor reactivity. Chris also agreed a Contact Record was an acceptable mechanism to document CDPHE concurrence/approval of this additional modification information.
