All parties reviewed the document during the meeting and agreed on the following changes:

Change "Life Cycle Baseline" to "Closure Project Baseline" throughout the IM/IRA.

Revise text in Section 1.2, Scope, to reflect that "clean fill" or "recycled building material" could be used as backfill. Revise text in Sections 4.1 and 4.1.3.2, accordingly.

Revise text to reflect that the ER ranking will be based on contamination levels found, if any. Revise text in Sections 4.1, 4.1.3.2, and 8.3, accordingly.

Eliminate the list of out-of-scope work items (i.e., deactivation) in Section 1.2, Scope. It was agreed that this information would be placed on the activity list for the project.

Add sentence to Section 2.1.1 that the ventilation system [with an accumulation uranyl nitrate salt] has since been removed.

Edit text in Section 2.2 to reflect that the potential COCs identified in the RLCP was "based on process knowledge."

Edit Table 2-4 to reflect that "previous radiological activities" were performed in Building 880.

Edit text in Section 4.1 and Tables 4-1 through 4-5 to delineate management reviews coordinated by K-H/DOE versus internal management reviews.

Remove the statement "Bulk contaminated material will be released or disposed in accordance with RFCA action levels".

Remove paragraph discussing site reclamation from Section 4.1.3.2.

Add Building 880 to Table 4-7.

Add an additional introductory sentence to Section 5.0 - "This section describes the work controls associated with the 886 Cluster Closure Project." Additionally, modify the title of the HASP to be consistent with the newly developed 886 Closure Project HASP

Add "Yes"/"No" decisions to Figure 5-1.

Add the sentence "Monitoring is routinely reviewed with the agencies through the Integrated Monitoring Process" to Section 5.3.5.

Modify text and title in Section 6.6 to replace the word "release" with "transfer".

Replace the word "nearest" with "any" in Section 7.1, bullet 2.

Change text in Section 10, Project Schedule, the text to indicate 24 months is required to complete rather than 18 months. Also change Attachment 1 reference in text to Figure 10-1.

Add text to Section 11, Organization and Responsibilities: "The organization and responsibilities do not represent an enforceable commitment and modifications to the organization and responsibilities do not constitute a modification to the decision document." Also revise Figure 11-1, Organizational Chart, to eliminate names.

Based on review of the changes suggested by T. Howell, it was agreed that editorial changes to the document would be made and a meeting to discuss the changes with T. Howell was set for April 21, 1998. Based on review of the suggested changes by J. Whiting, L. Brooks, and S.M. Lewis it was agreed that most of the text was confirmed to be consistent with the 779 IM/IRA and that several of T. Howell's comments would be easily addressed. It was agreed that after concurrence from T. Howell was received, document would then be reviewed with the EPA and CDPHE for concurrence.

The following significant (i.e., non-editorial) changes were made:

- The first and second paragraph's in the Executive Summary were reversed and reference to RFCA Part 9, Subpart B was added.
- The statement "The construction date of Building 880 is unknown" was removed in Section 2.
- The statement "Deactivation activities were suspended in late FY 97 because resources were diverted to other effort" was removed in Section 2.
- Reference to the 10 year plan was replaced with goal to close RFETS by year 2006 throughout the document.
- The statement that the "short-term protectiveness of human health and the environment is achieved by inaction" was expanded to include "because the cluster is maintained in safe and stable configuration" was added in Section 3.
- The statement "The objectives of the action....." was modified to simply state "The objectives of the action are to support release of the cluster for demolition."
- Text in Section 4.1.1. was revised to reflect consistency with 10 CFR 835.
- Reference to RFCA Attachment 5 was added in 4.1.3.2.
- Additional text regarding DOE Orders in relation to the OSHA construction standards was added to Section 5.
- Text in 5.3.5 was modified to reflect changes per L. Brooks.

- The WMP reference was updated in Section 6.0.
- Text describing the Chemical Consent Order was added to Section 6.5 and the section was retitled “Idle Equipment and Chemical Compliance”
- Order Docket Number was added to Idle Equipment Consent Order.

The following changes were not made for the reasons noted:

- The text deletions suggested in the first two paragraphs of the ES were not incorporated because the information had been included at the agencies request.
- The statement the “Funds made available in the future by performing the cluster.....” in Section 3.0 was not deleted because the information had been included at the agencies request.
- The area breakout in Section 4 was not eliminated because the area breakdown is consistent with the technical approach and the project schedule.
- The text with respect to management reviews was not revised because of concurrence by all parties in March 20 meeting.
- The Decommissioning Handbook was not appended as suggest in 4.1.2; however, it was agreed to confirm its availability in the reading room.
- Figure 4-1 was not eliminated because it represents a summary of the Decommissioning Handbook and the text introducing the Figure (4.1.2) was considered adequate.
- Table 4-7 was not eliminated because it represents a summary of the project decontamination approach and the text introducing the Table (4.1.2) was considered adequate.
- Section 4.2 was not eliminated because it was included at the agencies request.
- Figure 5-1 was not eliminated because it included at the agencies request.
- Text introducing Tables 5-1 through 5-4 (5.1) was considered adequate.
- Text in 5.3.4 was not revised because it paralleled text included in the 779 IM/IRA.
