Dear Mr. Smet:

Please find enclosed one copy of Phase I RFI/RI Workplan for Rocky Flats Plant Operable Unit No. 9, the Original Process Waste Line. The Phase I RFI/RI will concentrate exclusively on sources and soils. Thus, characterization of the pipelines (and associated tanks) along with their contents will be a primary objective.

We request that you review this work plan as your time allows and as you deem appropriate. Any suggestions you may have regarding pipeline/tank characterization based on similar experience at Hanford and other facilities would be greatly appreciated.

For your information, it is unlikely that pipeline/tank characterization at Operable Unit No. 9 will be initiated in FY 93 due to funding constraints. However, it is likely that a technical memorandum will be prepared in the summer of 1993 detailing the proposed pipeline/tank characterization activities for FY 94.
