Our meeting with ER personnel on March 22 and the revised documents provided have addressed all outstanding comments regarding the draft notification and SAP addendum. We appreciate the efforts of your staff to resolve our comments. The notification and addendum are approved. Based in information provided in the notification it appears that the amount of residual soil contaminated above background or MDL levels would be minimal at the end of remediation. Therefore, we believe that you should consider removal of this material so as to eliminate long-term management requirements.
