**RE: Reconnaissance Level Characterization Report (RLCR) for Building 335 - Concurrence**


Dear Mr. Legare:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division has reviewed the RLCR for Building 335, Revision 0 dated September 6, 2002. Based on the information contained in this RLCR, we are hereby concurring with the Type 1 designation for Building 335, with the following concern.

Considering waste burned in B335 is identified as having originated from B444 and contained depleted uranium as well as other possible contaminants, and B335 is associated with or adjacent to IHSSs 300-134N, 300-128, and 300-171, any below grade structures or appurtenances, such as the drains and sump, need to be properly characterized and managed prior to or during removal.
