**RE: Draft Industrial Area Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) FY03 Addendum #IA-03-03 IHSS Group 900-1 (B991 & 993) and Environmental Restoration RFCA Standard Operating Protocol For Routine Soil Remediation (RSOP) FY02 Notification #03-05 IHSS Group 900-1 (B991 & 993)- Approval**

Dear Mr. DiSalvo:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division has reviewed the SAP Addendum #IA-03-03, dated January 21, 2003 and the RSOP Notification #03-05, dated January 21, 2003. The Division has met with site personnel (Gerry Kelly and Susan Serreze), provided comments and received responses. Based on the information provided in the SAP Addendum and RSOP Notification, and inclusion of the modifications as discussed and agreed upon, the Division is approving the SAP Addendum #IA-03-03 and RSOP Notification #03-05.

Since the Division is approving the SAP Addendum and RSOP Notification prior to actually receiving the modified SAP Addendum and RSOP Notification, we are doing so with the understanding that any additional issues that may arise will be addressed and resolved utilizing the consultative process, which will also be utilized to keep us apprised of the ongoing activities addressed in the SAP Addendum or RSOP Notification.

Although the Division agrees that the Group 900-1 actions should properly identify the concerns associated with the 900-1 IHSS Group, the Division is also concerned that this sampling and resultant remedial activity, if required, is not being conducted to specifically identify or remediate possible source areas contributing to the contamination seen at GS-10, nor is it intended to characterize the fill that has been placed in this area. We have not been provided with a specific plan to identify through an investigation (collection of soil samples) either the GS-10 source or possible concerns regarding the fill around this area. As such, we expect additional investigations will be performed as necessary to properly identify the source or sources of the contamination seen at GS-10 as well as to properly

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
