RE: APPROVAL, DRAFT, ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION, RFCA STANDARD OPERATING
PROTOCOL FOR ROUTINE SOIL REMEDIATION, FY04 NOTIFICATION #04-04, IHSS GROUP 700-3

Dear Mr. Legare:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) hereby approves the subject notification to proceed with the excavation of contaminated soils identified to date.

Excavation may continue until confirmation samples yield satisfactory results for all constituents. However, relative to IHSS 700-118.1 and IHSS 700-132, the Division acknowledges that practical limits of excavation, rather than satisfactory confirmation samples, may dictate the extent of excavation activities. The consultative process and Regulatory Contact Records will provide a context for the final limits of excavation.

This approval is being granted prior to the full availability of characterization data for other IHSSs collected under SAP addendum #1A-03-04 approved on May 25, 2003. The expedited construction of a rail spur to facilitate cost-effective demolition and disposal of area building debris makes the early approval of this Notification necessary. Any excavation within other IHSSs of the group, that becomes necessary as additional data are received, will be addressed through an additional Regulatory Contact Record.

The issues and resolutions discussed above must be fully reflected in meeting minutes as part of the Administrative Record.


