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RE: Administrative Closure of RCRA Unit 993.1; Permit Modification #02-05

Dear Mr. Nesta and Mr. Legare:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the "Division"), has reviewed your letter dated April 15, 2002 (received by the Division on April 23, 2002) requesting to "administratively close RCRA Unit 993.1" and to remove this unit from the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site (RFETS) RCRA Permit No. CO-97-05-30-01 (the "Permit"). Unit 993.1 is a small skid-mounted metal enclosure that was permitted for the storage of containerized hazardous waste. As stated in your letter, Unit 993.1 was never used for the storage of hazardous wastes. The Division hereby approves the removal of Unit 993.1 from the Permit as a Class 1 permit modification (permit modification #02-05). In accordance with Section 100.511(b) of the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations, this approved permit modification shall become effective immediately. Procedures for appeal of this decision are contained in Section 100.514. Revised pages to the RFETS Hazardous Waste Permit are enclosed.
