CLEAN CLOSURE OF RCRA PERMITTED CONTAINER STORAGE UNIT MS-001, CONTAINER STORAGE SUB-UNIT 14 - AT BUILDING 906 - SMN-066-04

Dear Mr. Gunderson:

Pursuant to the "Rocky Flats Environmental Technology Site RCRA Part B Permit, Part X: Closure" effective 6/23/2004, which addresses closure of permitted units, Kaiser-Hill Company, L.L.C. (K-H) and the United States Department of Energy, Rocky Flats Program Office (DOE, RFPO) are submitting this letter to clean close RCRA Permitted Container Storage Unit MS-001, Container Storage Sub-Unit 14, in Building 906.

This unit is a single story, 25,000 square foot structure, used to store waste containers from February 1995 to December 2004. In accordance with Part X.D.1.a, Clean Closure Option #1, the unit's RCRA Operating Record, building files, spill response records and other applicable documentation were reviewed to demonstrate that hazardous waste was never spilled in the unit or that documentation exists to demonstrate that releases were adequately cleaned up. A review of these records (inspection logs are available for review) shows that a spill occurred on October 16, 1996, from a container of saltcrete (H05209). The crate was immediately overpacked and shipped from the unit and the "saltcrete material was cleaned up per spill response procedure." Additionally, a visual inspection of the unit confirms the absence of hazardous waste stains and/or residuals. Therefore, K-H and DOE, RFPO are requesting concurrence on attaining clean closure of RCRA Permitted Container Storage Unit MS-001, Container Storage Sub-Unit 14, in Building 906.
