I have received, from both you and Dave Kaunisto of the City of Westminster, requests for a letter stating that the Standley Lake Bald Eagles have left the area.

The Colorado Bird Observatory began monitoring the pair of Bald Eagles near Standley Lake on February 12, 1993, and began daily observations on March 10. The eagles have not been seen since March 22, and have apparently left the area. We will be submitting a formal report on April 10 to the City of Westminster covering the eagles' activities while they were in the area.
