Ref: J. D. Roberts ltr, JDR-119-93, to A. L. Schubert, Daily Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Inspections at Solar Ponds, April 14, 1993

A surface impoundment is considered operational as long as it contains hazardous waste. The inspection frequency for surface impoundments is based on 6 CCR 1007-3, §265.226, which requires daily inspections of freeboard levels as well as weekly inspections for leaks, deterioration or failure. When hazardous waste is permanently removed from a surface impoundment and closure is initiated, operational inspections may cease.

Based on the above, the daily and weekly inspections of the Solar Ponds as described in the Hazardous Waste Requirements Manual must continue. This is applicable to the ponds which contain hazardous waste. After hazardous waste is permanently removed from a solar pond, operational inspections may cease for that pond and closure per the Interagency Agreement (IAG) should then be administered.

Further RCRA operational questions may be directed to your Waste Technical Support representative or Bill Bruninga of RCRA Regulatory Programs at extension 8281. Questions on the Solar Ponds IAG closure should be directed to the Solar Ponds Remediation Project.

Ref: A. L. Schubert ltr, ALS-237-93, to J. D. Roberts, Daily Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Inspections at Solar Ponds, April 23, 1993

The attached reference indicates, "After hazardous waste is permanently removed from a solar pond, operational inspections may cease for that pond and closure per the Interagency Agreement (IAG) should then be administered". The impact of ceasing Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) inspections for empty solar ponds is significant; 207A Pond was emptied in October 1992, 207B Center Pond will be emptied in October 1993, and 207B North Pond is planned to be emptied by October 1994.

Based on reference, Waste Solidification (WS) will cease all RCRA inspections for 207A Solar Pond effective Monday, May 17, 1993, unless otherwise directed. Appropriate log entries will be made in the WS daily foremen's log for the solar ponds and signed by the WS Operations Manager on May 17.

Request that any possible concerns that you may have be immediately brought to my attention so they can be resolved prior to May 17, 1993.
