CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION FOR THE REPRIORITIZATION OF THE ORIGINAL LANDFILL OPERABLE UNIT (OU) 5 PHASE I RCRA FACILITIES INVESTIGATION/REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RFI/RI) WSB 410 93

Ref W S Busby ltr WSB 270 93 Certificate of Completion for the Reprioritization of the Original Landfill Operable Unit (OU) 5 Phase I RCRA Facilities Investigation/Remedial Investigation (RFI/RI) May 21 1993

This letter serves to remove two action items from the Plant Action Tracking System (PATS) because the tasks are being completed and tracked under the Interagency Agreement (IAG) The IAG is in PATS

The reviewers made their recommendations based on review of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Plans for Low Priority Sites (06/01/88) The low priority site plans are now out of date The C series ponds [individual hazardous substance sites (IHSSs) 142 10 and 142 11 and the Original Landfill (IHSS 115) in the Low Priority Sites Work Plan] have been superseded by the IAG and are now part of Operable Unit (OU) 5 Table 5 of the IAG lists the Draft and Final OU 5 Phase I RCRA [Resource Conservation and Recovery Act] Facilities Investigation/Remedial Investigation (RFI/RI) Report and associated milestone deliverable dates

The IAG is the Federal Facilities Compliance Agreement between the Department of Energy (DOE) the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Colorado Department of Health (CDH) for the environmental cleanup of the Rocky Flats Plant (RFP) The IAG schedules were negotiated and incorporated into the RCRA/CERCLA [Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act] corrective action response process in accordance with the scope of work stipulated in the IAG During negotiations sequencing of cleanup activities for upstream/downstream sites were carefully considered

The sequence of events that led to the remediation activities at the C series ponds and the Original Landfill will be addressed in the Feasibility Study (FS) a component of the IAG Upon agency approval of the Phase I RFI/RI Report the stakeholders (DOE EPA and CDH) will make a determination if additional Remedial Investigations (RI) are required If

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additional work is required a Phase II program will be initiated If the Phase I Report is approved as the Final RFI/RI Report then the Feasibility Study (FS) will begin The FS will look at the different options of remediating contamination and recommend a cleanup action (or no action) A component of the FS would include the sequencing of cleanup activities At this time it is premature to determine the degree to which cleanup will be required and which IHSS will require cleanup

The remaining IAG OU 5 milestones (2) the Draft Phase I RFI/RI Report and the Final Phase I RFI/RI Report are currently being renegotiated with the regulatory agencies If the extension request of one year is granted then the Final Phase I RFI/RI Report will be delivered to the regulatory agencies in May 1995 The FS which will sequence the cleanup work will commence when the Final RFI/RI has been accepted
