The Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division of the Colorado Department of Health (Department) received and completed an initial examination of the Engineering Design and Operation Report for a Sanitary Landfill to be located on the Rocky Flats Plant in Jefferson County. The report was received in this office on February 28, 1992. This initial examination of completeness of the information submitted was performed accordance with the Solid Waste Disposal Sites and Facilities Act, Title 30, Article 20, Part 1 of the Colorado Revised Statutes as amended (the Act) and with the Regulations Pertaining to Solid Waste Disposal Sites and Facilities which were promulgated thereunder, and are codified in 6CCR 1007-2. Section 30-20-102 (2) of the Act requires the Department to perform this initial examination within thirty (30) days of receipt.

It is the assessment of the Department, based on our initial examination, that your Engineering Design and Operation Report is substantially complete.

Please note that it is not the intent or purpose of a initial examination of completeness review to imply anything concerning the final approval of a proposed site and facility. Also, the Department may request additional information in order to clarify aspects of the report.

As per the provisions of section 30-20-103 (3) you are hereby notified that the Department is initiating the formal technical review process. This review shall be completed within one hundred fifty (150) days of the date of this initial approval, which is July 28, 1992.
